Dear Abe,

It has been several months since we have been in contact. I have often thought

of you and wondered how you are getting along. I hope you are well.

It is in fact a pity to have lost contact. It also is not good from an organisational coordination point of view.

As I have virtually no information about your activities, there is little I can do to provide guidance or assistance.

After Manila we have been busy with both organisational and routine information matters, as well as the constant battle for finding material resources to keep our operations going.

There have been a number of visitors to East Timor who have needed assistance. You may have seen the results of some of these visits, including the UN Special

Rapporteur and Japanese parliamentarians. Also the July events have required much media work to publicise and denounce.

In July a set of video interviews were made in ET by a Darwin supporter. These include excellent and very potent interviews with Bishop Belo, the second of the Clandestine Resistance, and many common people. I am having copies made, for distribution to our representatives. You will of course get one too. I have

also requested copies of a talk by Jose Ramos Horta to solidarity groups in Sydney last month, summarising CNRM current diplomatic campaign work and objectives. Very useful clarification. There is also a video on Falintil with recent material. It was done in Sydney. As soon as copies become available I'll

send them.

You are surely following the political situation in Indonesia. Regime repression is on the increase, which is going to lead to increased clashes. All

of this will eventually discredit the regime further, and as such is positive for us.

I imagine you have seen the documents of the Amnesty International campaign on Indonesia and ET, launched in Bangkok 2 days ago.

The main concern of Jakarta at present seems to gag all possible protest and dissidence during the APEC meeting in mid November. Clearly our solidarity supporters in Canada should generate as much activity to denounce the regime as

possible at the time, and the Canadian links with it.

This should be a MAJOR priority at present.

A further one should be in connection with 1975 being the 20th anniversary of the occupation. The year should be singled out as a special year of action.

I would be VERY pleased to receive a report with a summary of your activities over the last few months.

I also would like to know what plans you have regarding Jose Ramos Horta's Diplomacy Training Course. It is scheduled for January, either in Sydney or Bangkok.

I leave on 15 October for Malaysia and Europe for several weeks. I will have this e-mail address with me, so you can contact me. I was unfortunately unable to fly via Canada because of costs.

Mrs Ade Rostina is part of the 'Joint Committee for the Defence of East Timorese' in Jakarta. This is a group of Indonesian prominent Human Rights defenders and Church people who take care, among others, of the welfare of ETeSe prisoners. They work out of a Human Rights NGO, 'ELSAM' which acts as the Joint Committee's secretariat. Ph/fx +6221 573 4744. If you communicate with

them, be cautious with the language you use as the lines may be intercepted.
